At a glance:

Mobility

- The shop is all on one level.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Accessible Toilet
 - Shop

Hearing

- We have a hearing loop in the shop.
- Pen and paper is readily available if required.

Visual

- Glass doors and full-height windows have contrast markings.
- The walls and the doors have good visual contrast.
- Good lighting levels are available throughout the shop.
- Simple, page magnifiers are available.
- Support will be made available to any guests with visual impairment who may need help finding their way around the shop.

General

- On-line and telephone ordering is available.
- We welcome customers phoning ahead to discuss any particular requirement.
- The public toilet is suitable for disabled visitors.



- Assistance dogs are welcome and provided for on request. No other dogs are allowed inside the shop.
- There is a virtual tour of the site available on [Google street view here](#) (please note old décor but access etc hasn't changed) and customers are welcome visit at any time during opening hours in order to familiarise themselves with the venue.
- First Aid Kit is available on-site.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Northern Tea Merchants by bus.
- The nearest bus stop is on Chatsworth Road. The bus stop within 0.1 miles / 0.2 km from Northern Tea Merchants.
- There are a selection of buses which connect us to the town centre for example, No 90, 91, 170.
- You can book a taxi with City Taxis by calling 01246 222 222. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicles which should be requested at the time of booking. More information on Accessible taxi's available in town can be found on the [Chesterfield Borough Council website here](#).



Parking

- There is 2 hour on-street parking available along Chatsworth Road to the front of the building with lowered kerb access.
- Further, there is a car park to side and rear of Northern Tea Merchants and there is level access from here to the entrance. The car park is on a level, solid surface.

Arrival



Pavement to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The pavement to 3000mm wide, or more.



Main entrance

- The main entrance has level tarmacked surface access.



- There is weather protection above the entrance area in the form a recessed porch.
- The main door is side hung and the clear opening width of the entrance doorway is 850mm wide.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

- Good lighting levels are available throughout the shop.
- Page magnifiers are available.
- Large print menu is available upon request.

Accessible Public Toilet

- There is a public toilet for disabled visitors.
- From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access. The route is 850mm wide, or more.
- The toilet door opens outwards with a clear opening width of 780mm wide. However the entrance corridor is 670mm at its narrowest point.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is from left to right as you look at the toilet.
- There is 1200mm space in front of the toilet. The toilet seat is 440mm high. The height of the sink is 760mm to the underside.
- There is a grab-rail on the inside of the door.
- There are level taps and paper towels are available.
- The nearest fully accessible toilet for any customers that need a larger facility is available along Chatsworth Road at Morrison's (1993 Bobbin Mill Lane, Chesterfield, S40 3DP).

- We have a hearing loop in the shop area.
- We can provide water bowls for assistance dogs on request.
- You can hire mobility equipment from Care 100 based on Chatsworth Road, a mobility equipment hire company by calling 01246 275 767.

Emergency evacuation procedures

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.

Customer care support

- We have information in large print.
